

### LETTER FROM THE CEO

Hi All,

The October Vaxathon was a great success with 201 people vaccinated. The commitment and collaboration between Winun Ngari Programs and Services is a credit to all involved. A BIG THANK YOU to all from myself and the WNAC Board of Directors.

It is clear that the WA Government are committed to ensuring our vulnerable people are fully vaccinated to protect them against COVID. Derby and surrounding communities are still identified as high-risk towns for low numbers of vaccinated people. Therefore, WNAC and Frilled Enterprises considers the safety of it's employees, clients, and wider community to be of critical importance. This is a position consistent with the workplace health and safety legislation that many health professions are governed by as they are delivering a health service to many vulnerable people. This legislation requires the Board of Director that governs WNAC and Frilled to ensure, as far as reasonably practicable, the safety of it's employees and others in the workplace.

That includes putting in place measures to reasonably protect the safety and well being of those individuals. It is well established that COVID-19 creates health and safety risks in the workplace, and by extension the broader (vulnerable) community. COVID-19 can have devastating effects on our community, from serious illness to death.

IT IS UP TO ALL OF US TO HELP MINIMISE THE RISK OF EXPOSURE TO COVID-19 IN THE WORKKPLACE AND PROTECT OUR FAMILIES, THE COMMUNITY, AND OUR REGION.

I encourage you all to inform as many of your families, friends and contacts to get vaccinated to avoid being hospitalised or dying from a disease that can be avoided through vaccination. This is important for you, your family, work colleagues and the clients that we deliver a service to daily. Our second Vaxathon is 5 and 7 November at the Derby Recreation Centre with food, drinks and activities for the children provided from 9AM - 6:30PM each day.


